OUR MISSION

The Waynesboro Symphony Orchestra is a non-profit arts organization that features a unique performance ensemble made up of professional, amateur, retired and student musicians. Serving the Waynesboro, Staunton, Charlottesville, Nelson County, and greater Shenandoah Valley communities, the WSO seeks to provide local, dedicated instrumentalists with opportunities to collaborate and share in the joy of music-making while adding cultural vitality to the region.

OUR JOURNEY

The WSO was founded in 1996 as the Waynesboro Community Orchestra. In its debut concert, 23 musicians performed works by Lully, Bach and Haydn. Over the past decade, the ensemble has grown significantly, having more than tripled the original personnel for some repertoire, which now includes works by Beethoven, Berlioz, Brahms, Copland, Mendelssohn, Mozart, Schubert, Tchaikovsky and Wagner. The ensemble has performed more challenging literature with each season, growing a repertoire that includes works from all centuries of the classical tradition. Highlights from recent seasons include performances of Beethoven's 5th, 6th and 7th symphonies, Berlioz' "Symphonie Fantastique," Brahms' 1st symphony, Copland's "Appalachian Spring," Gershwin's "Rhapsody in Blue," and Stravinsky's "Firebird" Suite. The WSO has welcomed members from many communities outside Waynesboro, including Charlottesville, Harrisonburg, Staunton and Richmond while performing in both Waynesboro and Staunton as well as fundraising concerts in Charlottesville. In addition, the orchestra regularly collaborates with professional soloists while remaining deeply committed to the WSO String School, which provides after school lessons to young string players. During the final concert of the 2005-06 season, which celebrated the orchestra's 10th anniversary, the organization officially adopted its current name, the Waynesboro Symphony Orchestra. Founding conductor Eric Stassen was succeeded in 2006 by Jean Montes, who served for a single season. In May 2007, Peter Wilson was appointed the WSO's 3rd Music Director. Dr. Wilson now leads the orchestra in its 19th season.
